Each year, the President's Office puts together a "Compendium," which is a compilation of data pertaining to the following areas:

CB Student Body
The Freshman Class
Admissions
Graduation
Tuition and Tuition Assistance

A copy of the Compendium is posted on the bulletin boards in STEM and the faculty work space by the main hallway. Here's some key information you might like to know:

This year, we have 1,156 students:

- 576 male and 580 female (virtually 50%-50%)
- 71% Catholic
- 45% Caucasian, 20% Hispanic, 13% Asian/Filipino/Pacific Islander, 6% African American, 1% Native American, 14.5% multi-national
- Our students come to us from 72 zip codes, with the largest groups coming from the Pocket and Elk Grove.

Freshman Class – 301 students

- Freshmen come from 49 zip codes.
- 56% are from Catholic schools, 44% are from public and other private schools
- 144 (48%) male and 157 (52%) female

Class of 2018

- 281 graduates
- 99% enrolled in college (83% in four year and 16% in community colleges)
- National Merit Scholars: 7 Commended, One Finalist

AP Exams

- AP Exams: 276 students, 581 exams administered in 19 subjects
- 38 AP Scholars, 15 AP Scholars with Honor, 37 AP Scholars with Distinction, 7 AP National Scholars

Tuition and Fees in 2018-19: \$14,147

Tuition Assistance: \$2.7 million awarded this year – CB leads the region in tuition assistance.

- 405 (35%) of our students receive financial aid.
- Average award is \$6,652
- 40 students receive full scholarships.
- 75 students (6%) are from families living below the federal poverty level.
