INTRODUCTION

THE new series of the De La Salle Arithmetics, by the Brothers of the Christian Schools, is arranged to meet fully the requirements of the best Syllabi in Arithmetic issued by the Departments of Education of the various States and Dioceses of the Country.

THE SCOPE OF BOOK ONE:

The first book of the series is intended to be used in the Third and Fourth Years of the Elementary School, and to serve as an aid for teachers in First and Second Years. The reading and writing of numbers, operations in the four fundamental rules, and a thorough review of these very important operations, with an introduction to Common Fractions, are stressed in this book.

METHOD:

The inductive method is used. As an example, we may call attention to the manner in which the idea of the fraction is developed in the text. Examination will show that other topics have been developed in a similar manner.

FEATURES:

To arouse the interest and to hold the attention of the child, Flash Cards and Games are made use of frequently in the work of the First and the Second Years.
