Here's what they had to say about their favorite parts of their unique experiences as student leaders during these unprecedented times.

Her advice for people wanting to sew masks of their own? "Don't be afraid to try. Watch some videos, find a pattern, and give it a go!"

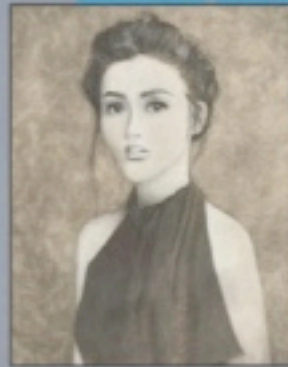

# Social Action Leadership Team





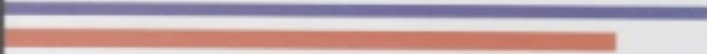

Victoria Zeigler: "Everyday, we learn something new about ourselves. Live everyday like it is going to be your last day as a high schooler."



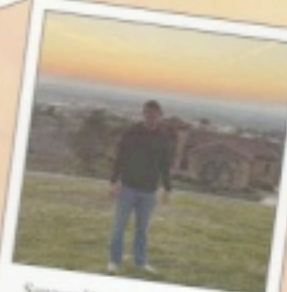
