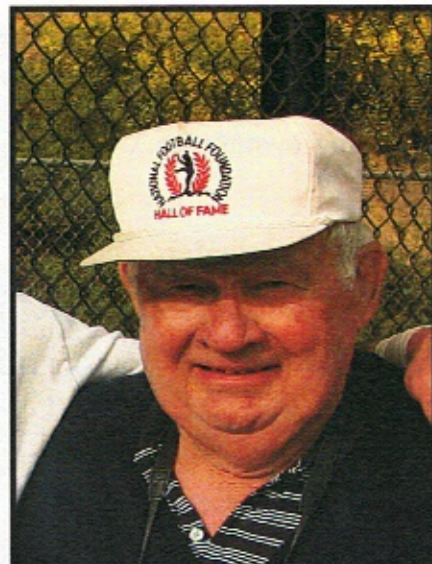
- *College of the Pacific (Now University of the Pacific), Stockton, CA. 1946-1950

- *Was also a star baseball player and second athlete in history of school to be chosen on two All-Conference teams in one year

Post College:

- *Started the Mira Loma Football Program when the school opened in 1960 and credited with bringing the wing-T offense to Sacramento
- *Won 9 CVC Championships in his 18 years of coaching
- *Between 1967-1972, his teams went 57-4-1
- *1968 team was ranked the number one team in NorCal, and was voted as one of the all time top 10 teams in area history in a 1995 Bee article
- *18 year coaching record at Mira Loma 125-50-4
- *Lodi Sports Hall of Fame inducted in 1975
- *Named Sacramento Bee Coach of the Decade for the 1960s

- *Mentoring his grandson, who is following in his footsteps as Athletic Director and Head Football Coach in Glendale

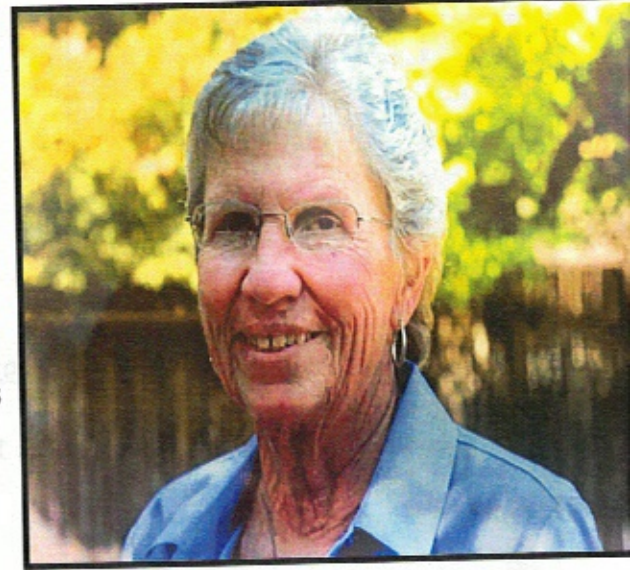


Jackie Box
