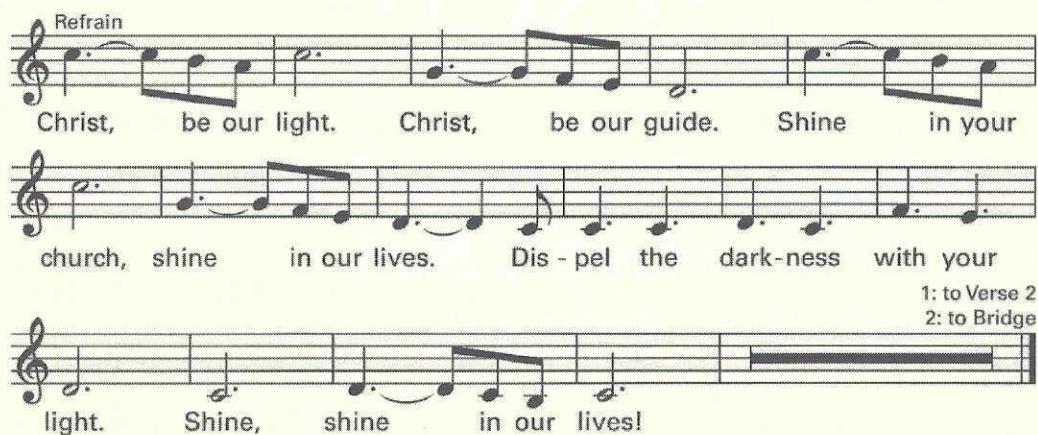

## Introductory Rite

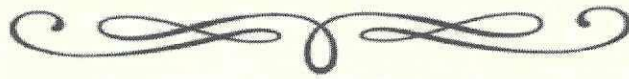
Gathering Song: *Christ, Shine in Our Lives* Chris Muglia

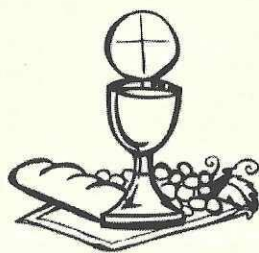

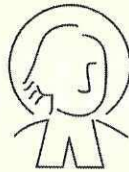
