Wally played for the Cards and Reds before coming to the Indians in '52. After breaking into pro ball in '40 and spending 3 years in the Service, Wally came up to the Majors with the Pirates in '47. From '47 through '51, he had Batting Marks of .273, .285, .282, .285 and .266 and HR totals of 17, 17, 23, 24 and 22 during those years. Wally batted in 104 Runs for the Pirates in 1950 and led NL outfielders in '50 with a .991 Fielding Mark.
