



THE CHRISTIAN BROTHERS TRADITION

The Institute of the Brothers of the Christian Schools (also known as the Christian Brothers), is a lay teaching order of men in the Catholic Church. Some 6,500 Brothers, along with 68,000 colleagues, conduct over 1000 educational institutions in 80 countries around the world. They were founded in 1680 in Rhoims, France, by St. John Baptist de La Salle, who in 1950 was declared Patron of All Teachers of Youth by the Church. The Brothers are devoted exclusively to "the human and Christian education of the young, especially the poor" (The Rule). As such, they are not priests; they are the largest non-clerical order of men in the church.

In 17° century France the Brothers devised a realistic education for those who otherwise would have been loft without any formal studies. De La Salle and the early Brothers pioneered many of the educational practices that are taken for granted today: simultaneous instruction (many students being taught together), instruction in the students' own language, special attention to reading and writing, practical educational goals, and an insistence on classroom discipline, social skills, and sound personal habits. Today the Brothers conduct grammar schools, secondary schools, and college or universities in cities around the world. They have associated themselves more and more with committed and talented lay teachers who share their sense of mission and participate in the "Lasallian" spirit —a living and ongoing 320-year spirit of education engendered by St. John Baptist de La Salle and the Brothers.

Christian Brothers High School has been operated by the Brothers in Sacramento since 1876 and is the second oldest high school in the city. Beginning on the corner of 12th and K Streets in Sacramento, in 1924 the school moved to the corner of 21st and Broadway, where it remained for 40 years. Until 1964, the school included a boarding department. The present campus dates from 1955, when the upper grades moved to the MLK Blvd. location. When the property at 21st and Broadway closed in 1964, the entire school moved to MLK Blvd. Over the years the school has also been known as St. Patrick's Institute, Sacramento Institute, Bishop Armstrong, Christian Brothers College, and Christian Brothers School. The school returned to the name "Christian Brothers High School" in 1968 and became co-educational in 1990. Today marks the one hundred and twenty-eighth commencement for the school.

There are a number of elements which, taken together, contribute to the identity of a school in the Lasallian tradition: 1) Commitment to living a Catholic and Lasallian heritage; guided by the Holy Spirit, everything is seen through the eyes of faith, 2) Commitment to working together and by association, 3) Commitment to service of the poor, 4) Teachers who are professionally qualified, dedicated to the school's mission and schoolwide learning expectations, committed to their own spiritual and professional development, and witnesses to the presence of God, sharing their faith with students, 5) Commitment to building safe, just, and joyful communities that foster fraternal relationships among all its members, and valuing inclusivity, diversity, and respect for the individual and the gifts they are called to share, 6) Providing a human and Christian education that is practical, academic, spiritual, social, and student-centered and that prepares students to be responsible citizens and to live a Christian life.

As lay men, the Brothers manage their schools with a certain independence from the hierarchy of the Catholic Church but respect the jurisdiction of the local Church authority. Thus they can identify with their lay colleagues, students and parents and so understand and support movements that further the role of laymen and laywomen in the life of the Church.
