LaSalle Club Minutes
October 24, 1995

Twenty six people were in attendance.

Opening Prayer: Brother Bertram

Nominations for office were submitted and were unanimously endorsed by the members.

Brother Bertram gave a brief history of the LaSalle Club.

Danny Delgado, Athletic Director, spoke of the need for a weight room, and a potential fund raiser, a golf marathon. Danny outlined the plan for the golf marathon - each golfer plays 100 holes, getting sponsorships for each hole played. The Lighthouse Golf course has been suggested - June is being considered for a date. Jon Snyder has agreed to be Chairperson of the event. Bill Conlin will be contacted and asked if he could assist with the publicity for the event. Gary Quatrain has offered to Chair the Committee for the Weight Room.

Norm Montgomery, has access to a building that he could donate. School personnel are investigating where such a gift could be placed, need for a cement slab, building permits, etc. Budgetary restrictions require that either a new weight room, or refurbishing the old weight room, would need to be underwritten by support groups such as the Boosters, the LaSalle Club and others. Very preliminary estimates are that a new building would cost approximately \$30,000, with an additional \$10,000 needed for equipment. Key people on the Board of Trustees, Don Gillott, Jefferey Knezovich, and Ron Carissimi will investigate expenses and report back to the LaSalle Club.

The Golf Marathon could be a major source of funding for this project. The Boosters, Faculty and Alumni will be asked to assist the LaSalle Club in the success of the Golf Marathon with active participation in playing, or getting sponsorships. Various suggestions were made regarding incentives to make the Marathon a success; T-shirts, Tee prizes, rewarding the most

pledges, awards for the most money raised, etc.

The membership agreed to a policy, that no monies from the LaSalle Club would be expended without specific approval of the Officers. Also members clarified the definition of support for school sports programs indicating their belief that support does not include involvement. They are very aware of the fine line between supporting and interfering. The belief is that coaches should be involved and consulted and that they, and the school, would set priorities to which the LaSalle Club would try to respond.

Ron Limeberger asked for names of those persons who should be honored with lifetime memberships to the LaSalle Club. The first honorees were presented with lifetime certificates at the "Old Timer's Night", August 19. Ron indicated there are many more persons who should be recognized for their service to the LaSalle Club and Christian Brothers High School and asks your help in identifying these people. Please contact Ron.

Lou Bordisso has renewed his offer to provide a plaque with the names of all the past presidents of the LaSalle Club. Ron Limeberger is researching names for the plaque.
