#### DIRECTIONS

#### From Folsom

Take Prairie City Road to White Rock Road and turn left. Go approximately 100 yards and turn right on Scott Road. Continue on Scott Road for about eight miles and turn left on Latrobe Road. Go approximately 100 yards and turn right on Stonehouse Road which will dead end into Jackson Hwy. Turn left onto Jackson Hwy. and left again at the stop light at the main entrance (Murieta Parkway).

Take Highway 50 east to Bradshaw Road. Proceed south to Jackson Hwy., (State Route 16), then travel east 13 miles to the stop light at the main entrance (Murieta Parkway).





#### RULES OF SCRAMBLE PLAY

1. Format of play:

A. Every player tees off on each hole. The best tee shot is used (as decided by the foursome).

NOTE: If you are playing in a threesome, one player may take an extra shot...players must rotate the extra shot between all three players on each hole.

- B. After choosing the best tee shot, each player in the foursome places his/her ball at that position and continues to play for that hole. If the selected shot is in the rough or a hazard, all player's shots must be played from a similar lie.
- C. Likewise, after the second shot (or putt, if the ball reaches the green), each player hits a third shot from the single best shot position. This format continues until the ball is holed out. Putts shall be taken from within six inches of the selected shot, but not closer to the hole.
  - D. One score is recorded per foursome per hole.
- 2. Tee shots: Each team shall play a minimum of three tee shots from each player and will mark them accordingly on the team score card.
- **3. Mulligans:** Each player may purchase two mulligan coupons. Mulligans may be used to re-hit any shot during the competition.

NOTE: Mulligans are meant to be used by the player who purchased them and are NOT meant for the entire team.

- **4. Long Drive Competition:** The longest drive coming to **rest in the fairway** on hole #8 (for men) and hole #11 (for women) will win a prize. If your shot is farther than the sign, add your name and move the sign to where your shot finished. There will be separate signs and prizes for men and women. Only a player's first drive qualifies for the prize. Mulligans do not count for prizes.
- 5. Tees: Men will hit from the white tees. Women will hit from the red tees.
- Closest-to-the-pin prizes will be awarded on each of the four par three holes.Only a player's first tee shot qualifies for the prize. Mulligans do not count for prizes.
- 7. Absent Player: If a player is absent, the remaining three players in the group will equally alternate playing a 2nd ball.
- **8. Tie Breaker:** Any scores tied for the first three places will be broken by a score card playoff beginning on hole #1.
- **9. Note:** Do not "play out" after completing your last hole. We need all golfers to return promptly to the clubhouse after golf. Teams not turning in their scorecards in a timely manner will be disqualified.
