Through his restaurant, the Florez Café, he has been a long time participant in the Wine, Beer & Food Extravaganza serving food at the event, and serving as a shuttle stop for event transportation. We are grateful for Roger's generous support and pleased to confer upon him an Honorary Diploma.

Special Recognition

Class of 1954 and 1955

One of the most significant things an alumnus can do, is to help ensure that Christian Brothers High School remains strong, and that we pass the gift of a CB education on to the next generation. It is important that we each recognize that we are part of a larger legacy, that we were given a gift in our education, and that we can "pay it forward" to the next generation of alumni. Today, there are hundreds of families who need tuition assistance in order to give their kids the great education available at CBHS. Alumni donations help these young men and women attend CB by providing tuition assistance.

In 2008, members of the Class of 1955 initiated the Class Sponsorship program. Classmates Bob Granucci, Dick Giusti, Terry Dorsey, John Giordano, Leo Granucci and Jerry Williams joined together to encourage contributions from the Class of 1955 in order to cover tuition for one student for one year. Soon after, the Class of 1954 joined the effort, under the leadership of Ken Harris, Larry Lynch and Frank Silvey.

Since then, these two classes have both raised enough money each year to fully fund a student attending CB. Their work has been an inspiration to other classes who have started their own Class Sponsorship efforts.

This year, because of the generous support of our alumni and donors, 393 students receive nearly \$2.2 million in tuition assistance, up from 171 students (\$1.1 million) just five years ago.

Tonight we would like to offer special recognition to the Classes of 1954 and 1955 for their work on the Class Sponsorship Program, serving as an example of generosity and inspiration for all of us, and by doing so embodying the mission of St. John Baptist de La Salle.
