Some of the projects we were able to help fund were: water polo caps, end zone cameras for the football program, a basketball shooting machine, renovation of the infields for the baseball and softball fields, a timing clock for swim meets, championship jackets for the boy's varsity soccer team, installation of AV equipment for the weight room, and shoulder pads for the football team.
