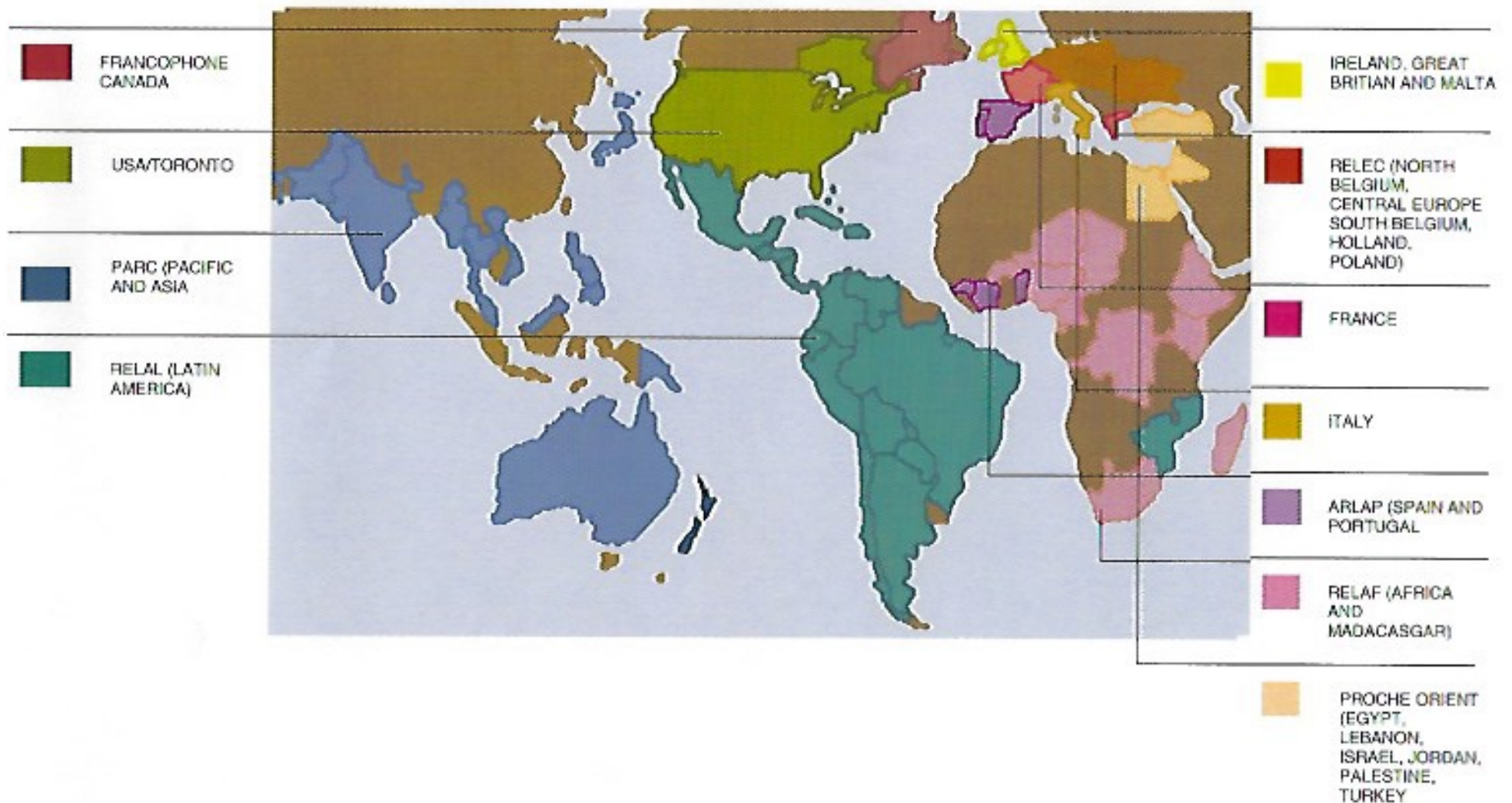

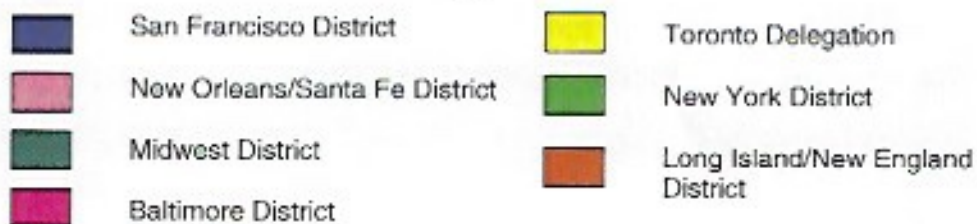
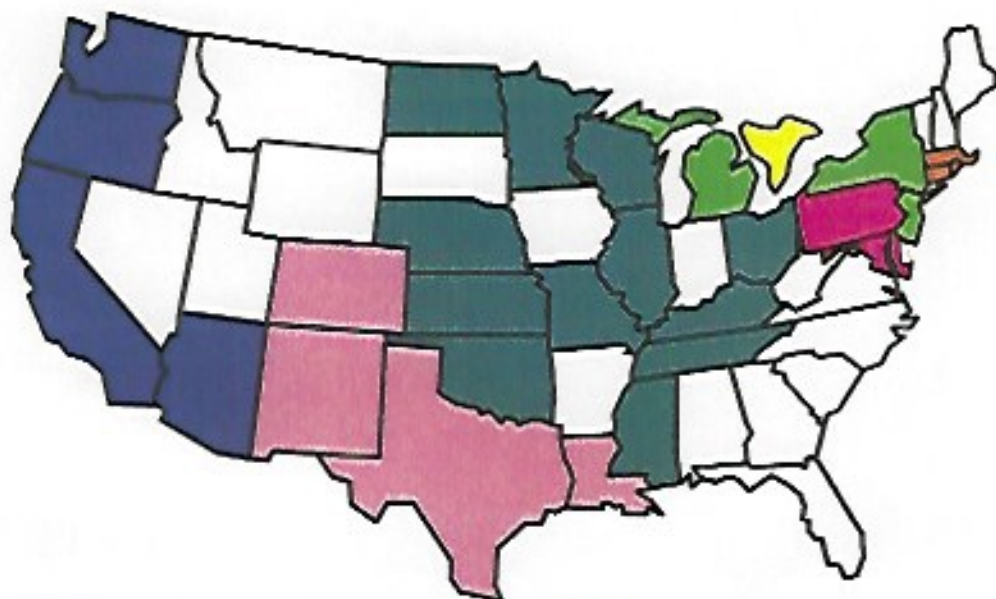

Districts of the United States/Toronto Region



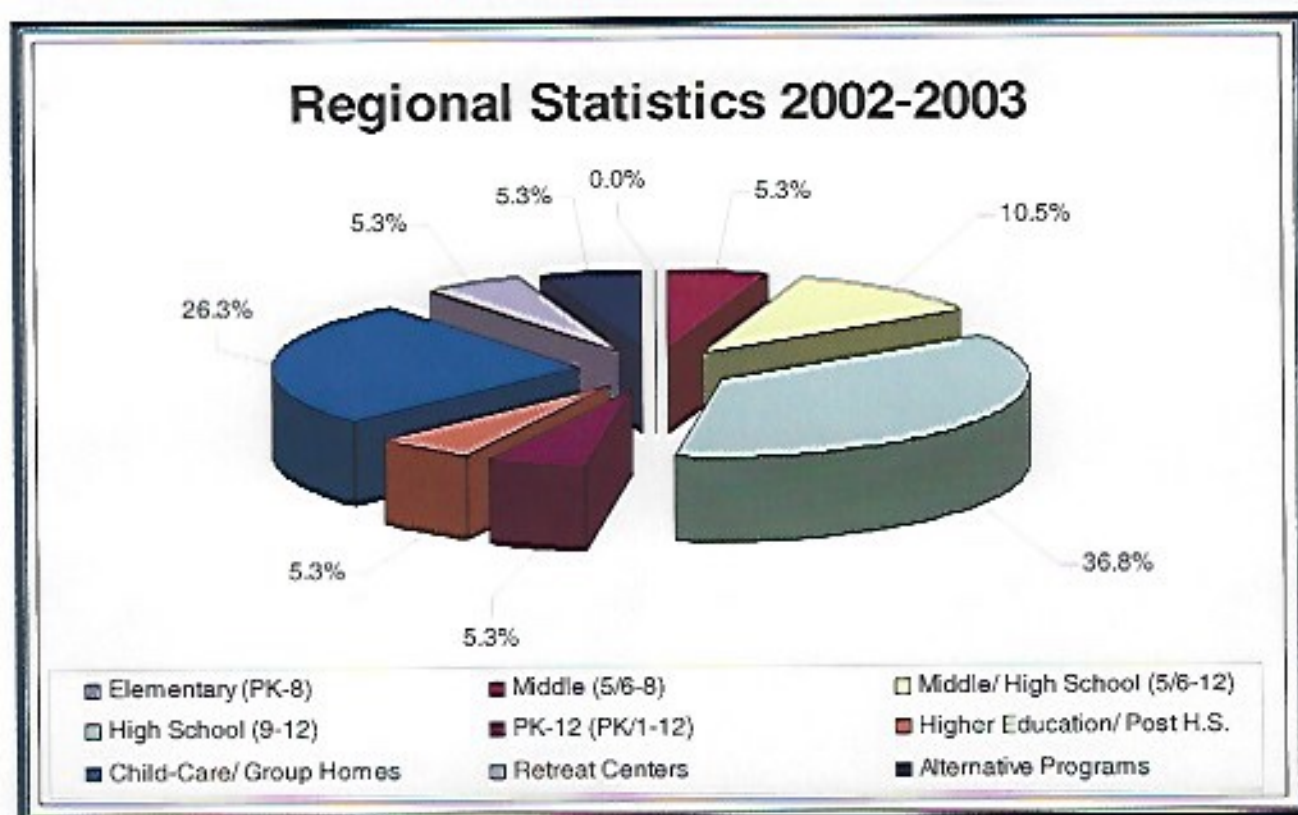
United States/Toronto Region 2002-2003 Statistical Report

In 2002 – 2003, the six Districts of the United States/Toronto Region, along with the Toronto Delegation, are responsible for 103 ministries. The fastest-growing group in the Region is the Lasallian Association of Miguel Schools (LAMS), which included three schools in 2000 and now includes thirteen schools, with three more to be added in Fall 2003 and at least one school to be added in Fall 2004. Alternative programs, group homes, child-care agencies, and San Miguel schools account for one-third of the ministries of the Region. The largest percentage of ministries in the Region continues to be the fifty-eight (56.3%) secondary schools (including eight Middle/High schools, forty-eight High schools, and two PK-12 programs).

In addition to these 103 educational institutions, the following ministries serve the Region and the wider Church: Saint Mary's Press, Sangre de Cristo Center for Christian Studies, Christian Brothers Services, Christian Brother Investment Services, and Christian Brothers Conference.

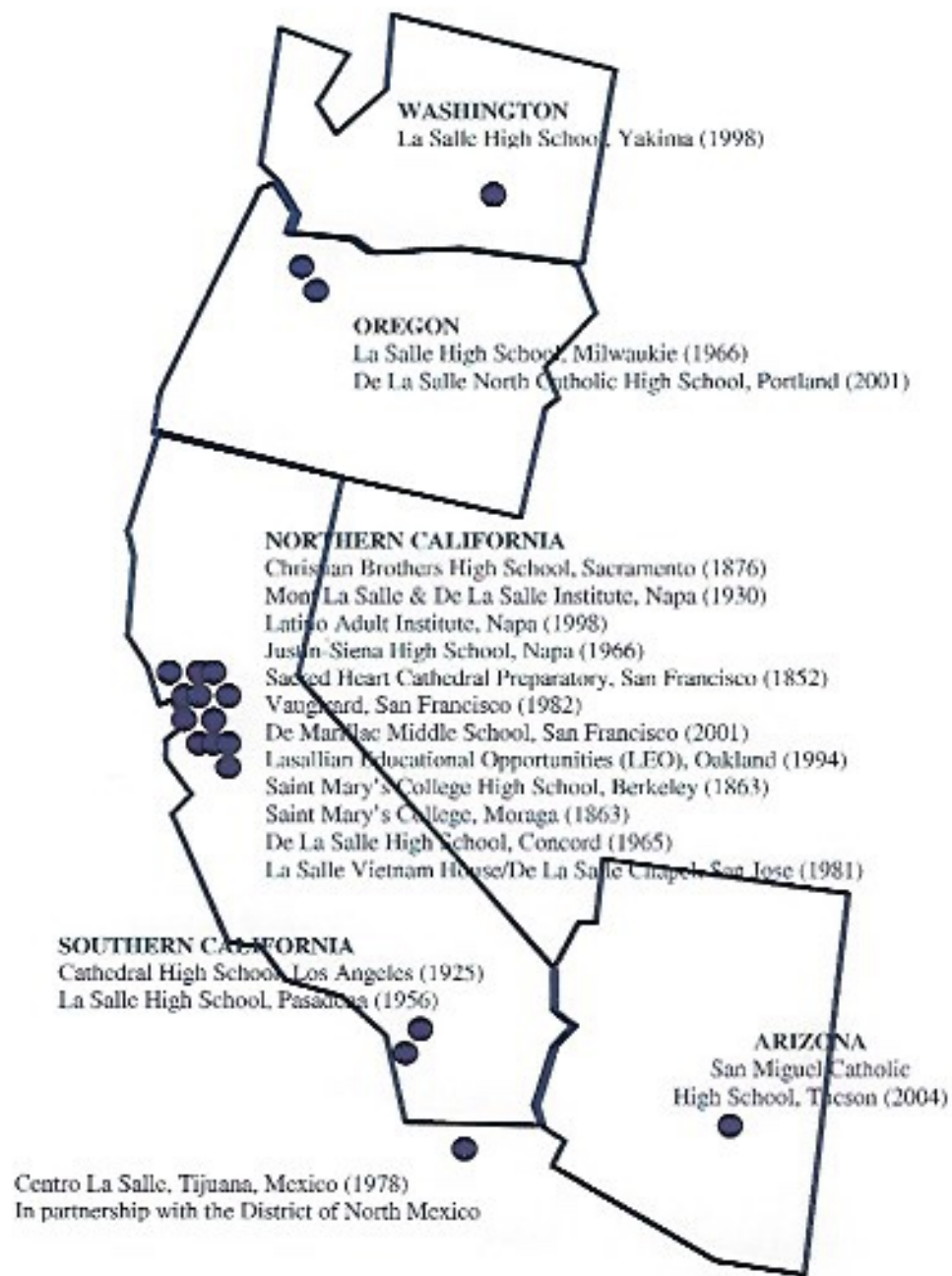

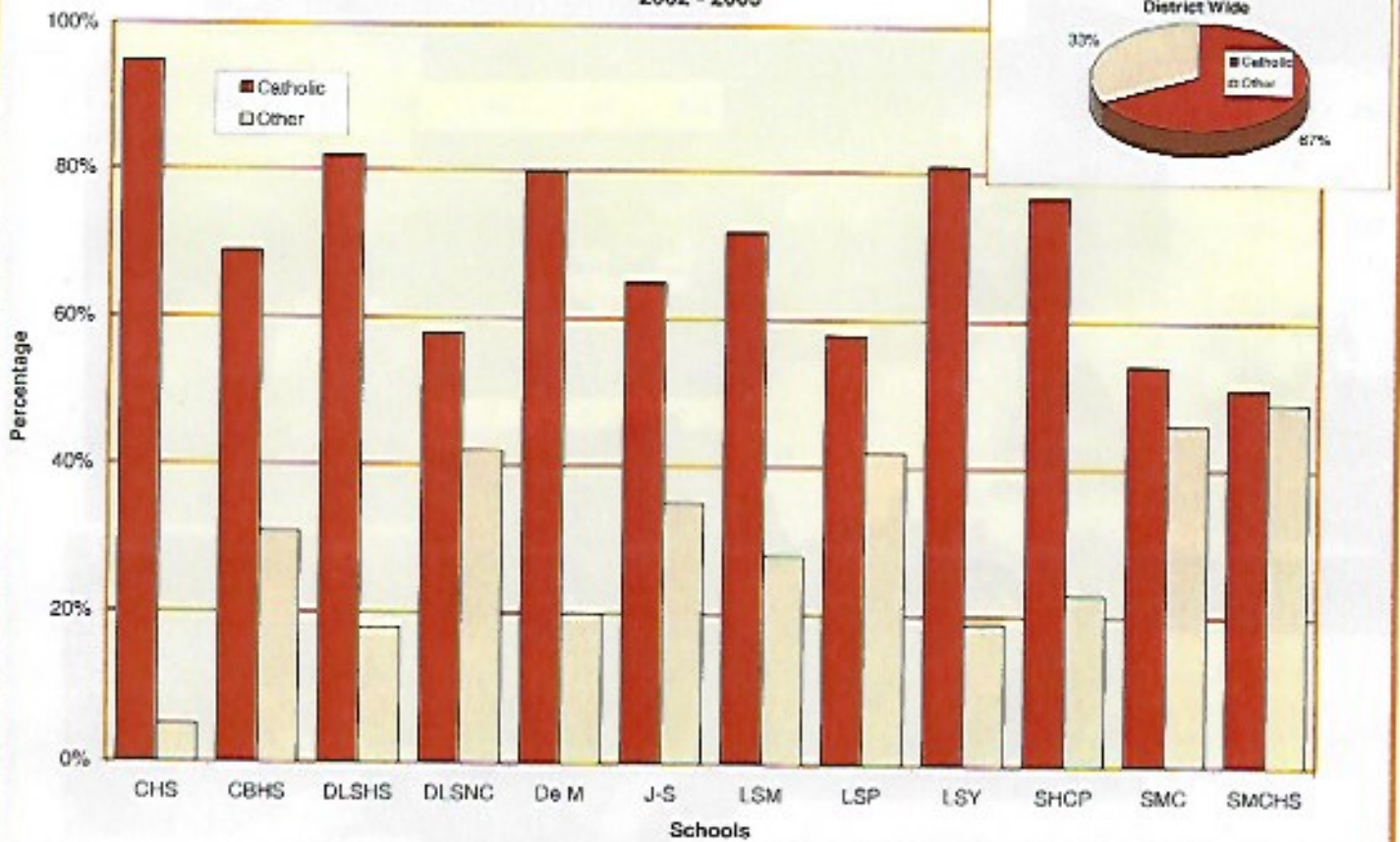
Demographics and Statistics 2002 – 2003



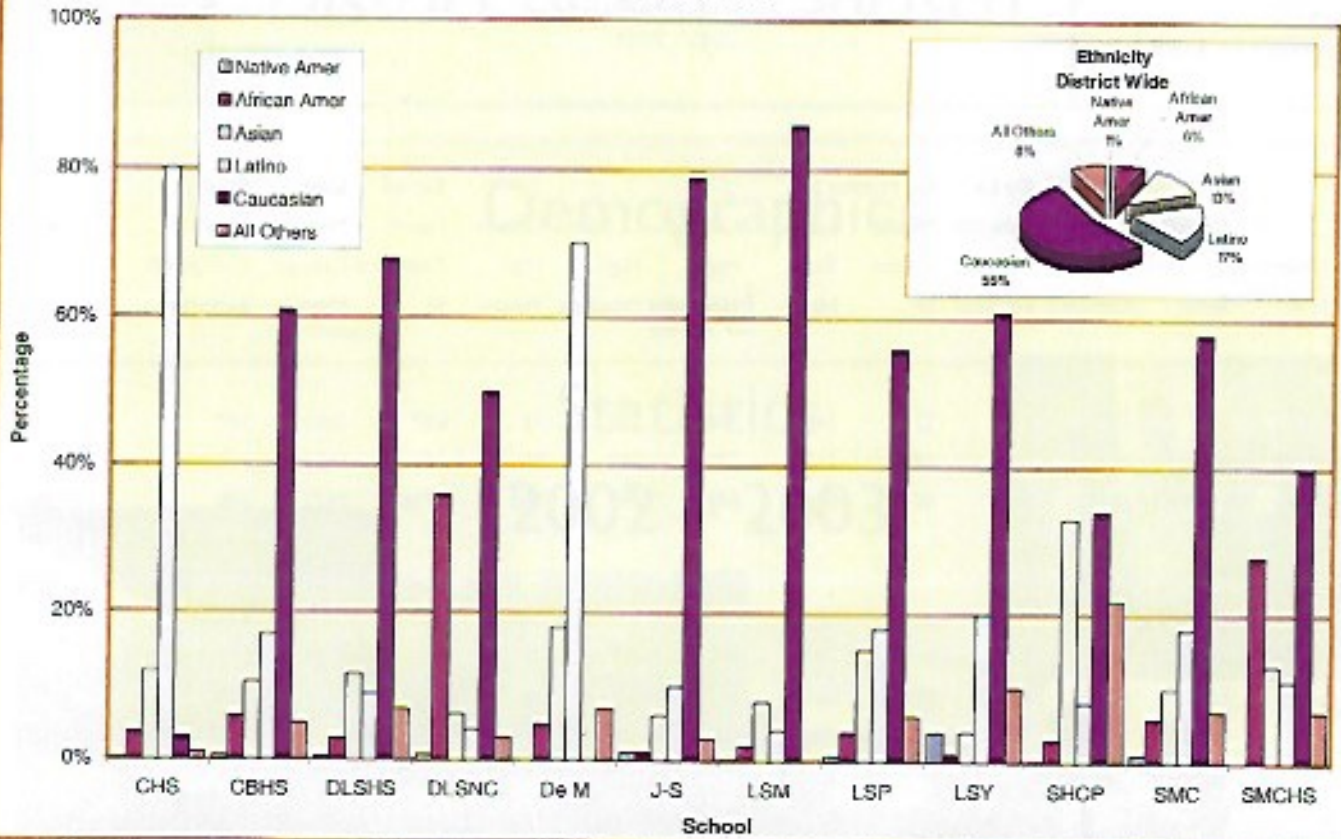
Enrollment

2002 - 2003



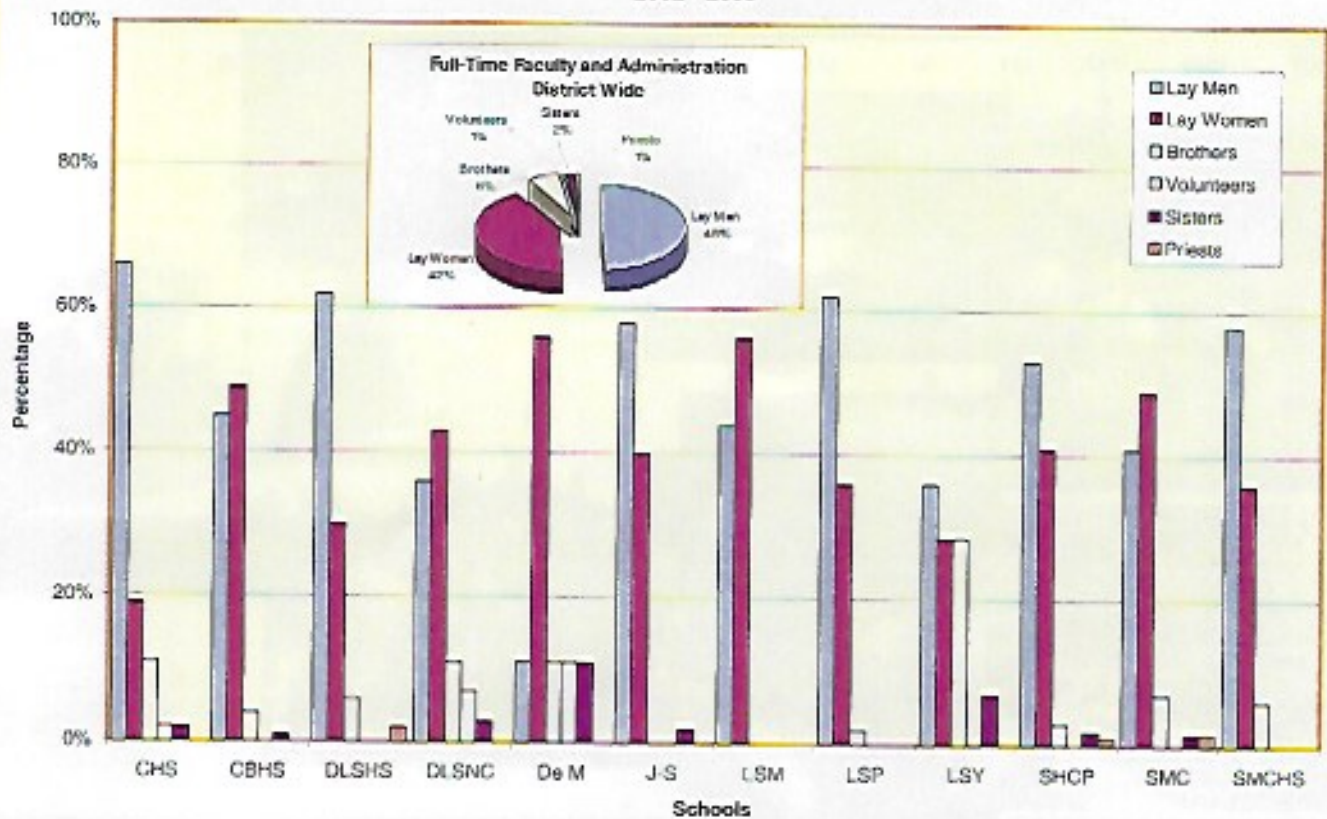
Religion
