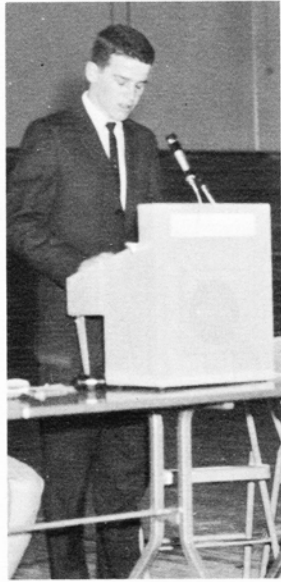

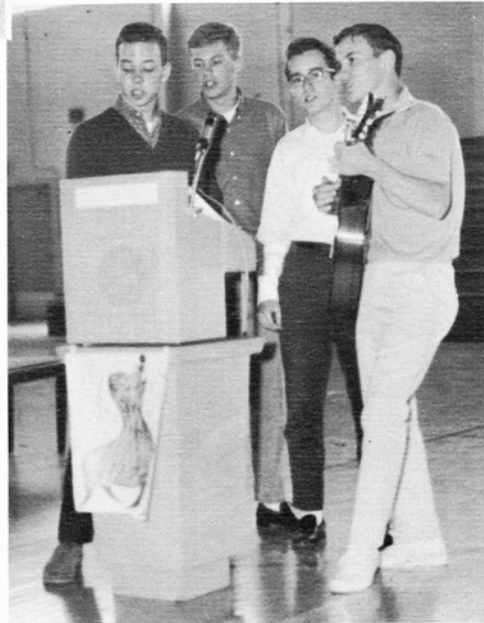

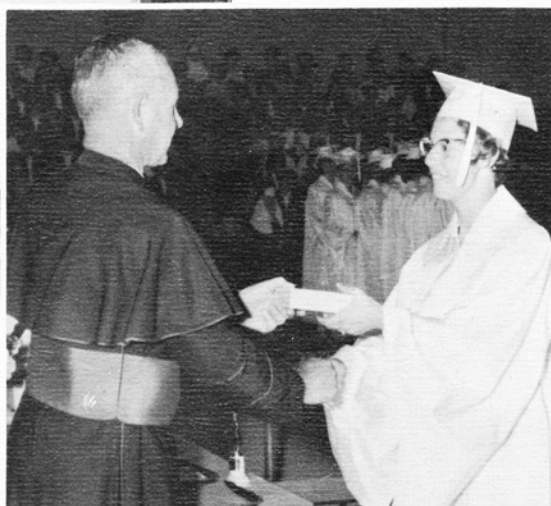

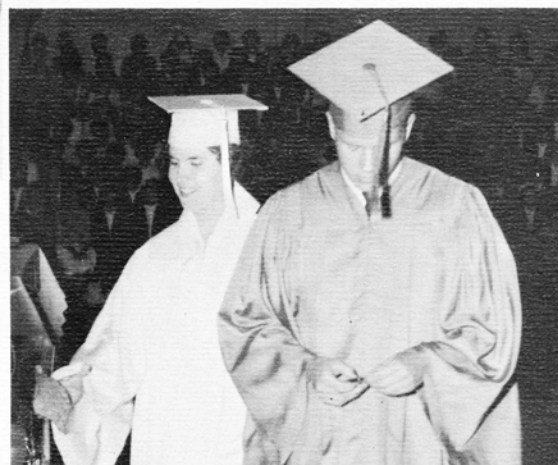

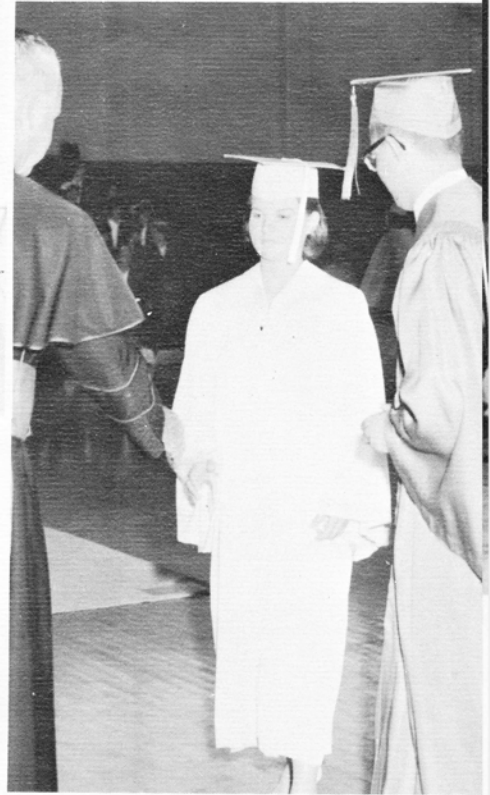

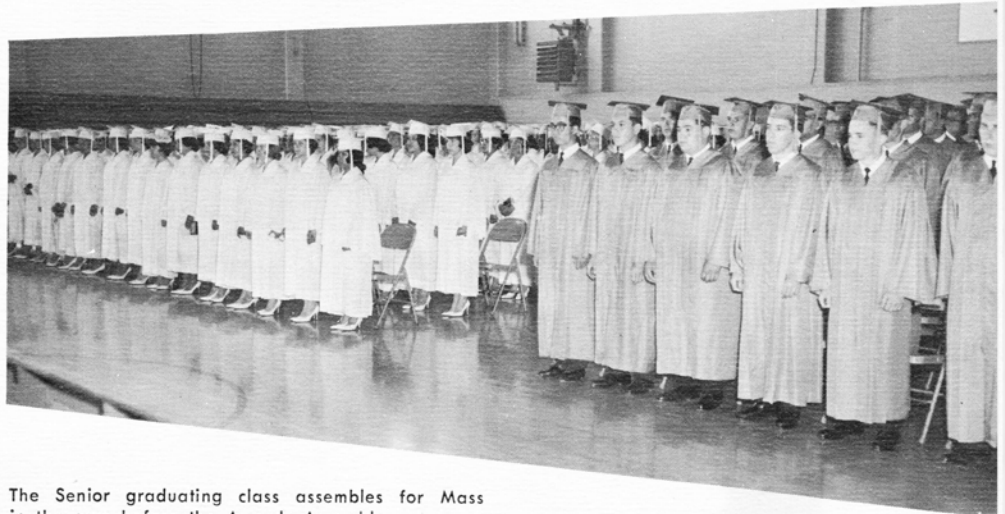

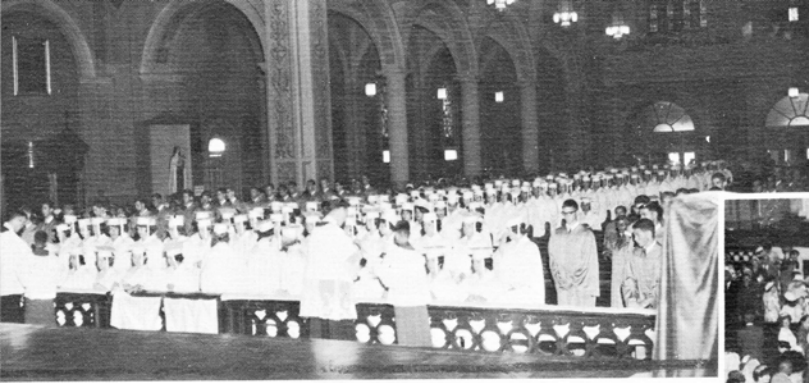

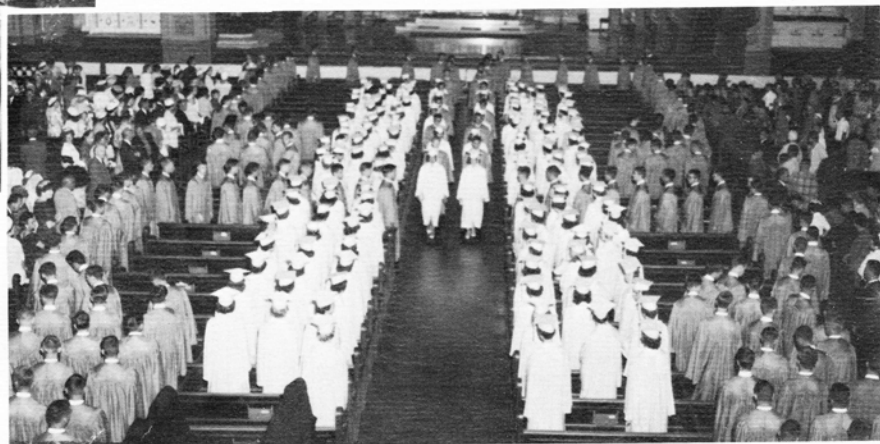

The Senior graduating class assembles for Mass in the gym before the Awards Assembly.



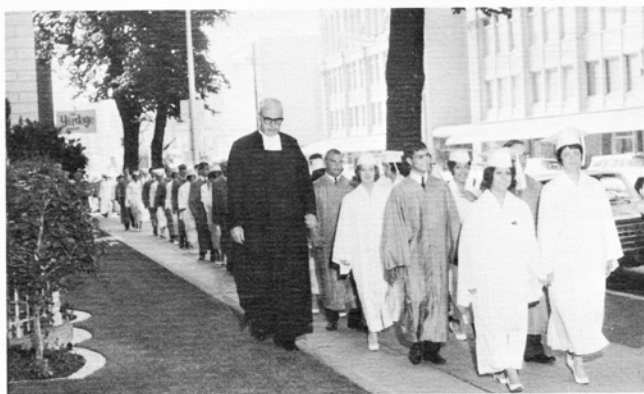

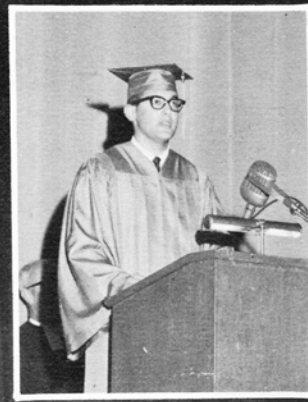
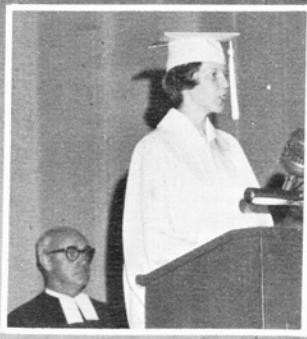


Brother Eugene gives last minute instructions in the basement of the Cathedral.

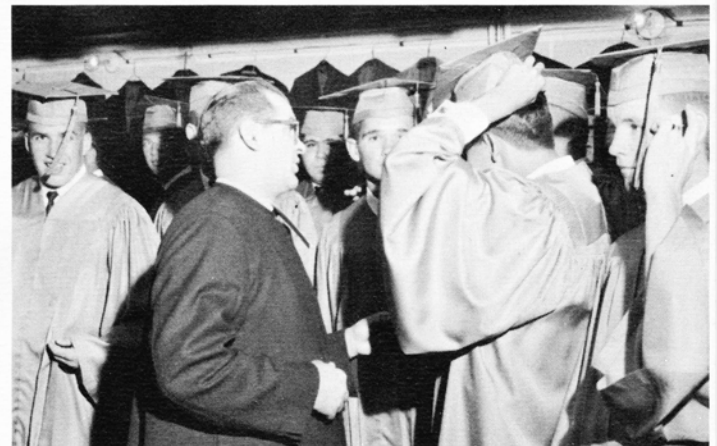
