

32. Brother Victor Ambrose (William H. Reilly) 1884-1974

He entered the Brothers from San Francisco as a Junior Novice at the age of fourteen. Much of his teaching career was spent at Christian Brothers High School in Sacramento, where he is still fondly remembered. Legend has it that, while serving at Saint Peter's School in San Francisco, he was shaken from his bed during the earthquake of 1906 – when he was supposed to be in the chapel for morning prayer. He is recalled to have been one of the best-loved Brothers in the District.

Brother hade a long career as a brother and serving Sacramento. He first came in 1901, left and came back 1910 to 1912, than came back in 1930 until 1970. I believe that Sacramento was his last teaching assignment.
