The Alumni Board is pleased to honor Jack Stassi, Class of 1940 with the 2003 Alumni Service Award. For the better part of 50 years, Jack has tirelessly organized and mobilized generations of alumni in support of the CB mission.

He, along with Ted Garner '38, coordinated the first annual alumni banquet in 1955 with 250 CB grads in attendance. The next year the event was so big, they held it at the school. They realized that they had tapped into a real desire on the part of the alumni to stay in touch and give something back to their school; thus the Alumni Association was created, and Jack served as its first president from 1956-57.

Jack was also part of the original planning that created the Board of Regents. He served as its second president in the late 1960's and continued serving as a member for the next 13 years. In 1967 while he was president of the Board of Regents, CB began publishing the *Connection* magazine. Jack agreed to write the articles until someone else was found to do it. Well, it's 36 years later and Jack is still writing an article for the *Connection*.

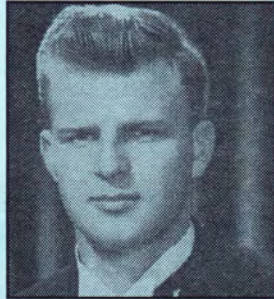
We would like to extend our congratulations and thanks for Jack's unselfish commitment to Christian Brothers High School.
