Assembly: Amen.

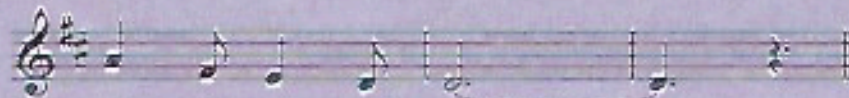
